The MASA Five means that every club instructor should have:

1. A traceable **Black Belt** or equivalent in the martial art being taught.
2. An approved coaching qualification including first aid
3. £5 million Professional Indemnity Insurance.
4. An enhanced CRB disclosure.
5. A clear pricing policy with no hidden charges.

MASA is a lead body in the Martial Arts structured as a non profit making company limited by guarantee with no paid employees and no expenses paid to it's directors. All give their time voluntarily because they believe that standards in the Martial Arts are of vital importance.

The objective is to encourage nationally recognised standards in all martial arts clubs and associations to help facility providers, insurers, prospective students and parents find a professional, well administered, safe and caring environment in which people of varying needs can train.

**If your Instructor can't produce the MASA 5 when asked, then you should reconsider your options.**
